When to call 911

Dial 911: emergency that is happening NOW.

Dial 231-1212: for non-emergency situations.

Dial *67-231-1212: for emergency or non-emergency situations, when you want to remain anonymous.

How to call 911

- Always find out the address where the crime/disturbance is occurring before you call 911, non-emergency, or the anonymous emergency.
- Never give your address unless the disturbance is occurring at your property.
- Remember the following so you can give these to the operator:
 1. The address where the crime is occurring.
 2. The behavior such as Drug use/paraphernalia, Illegal weapons/shootings, False/frivolous 911 calls, Explosives, Prostitution, Gambling, Illegal sales of alcohol, Domestic violence (not the victim but abuser), Fights, Assaults, Suspicious Person/Drugs, Disturbances
 3. The number of people involved.
 4. The names of the subjects and where they live (if known). Make sure you tell the operator if the offender lives at the property that you are calling about.
 5. The person's physical characteristics such as height, weight, race, beard or scars and their clothing descriptions.
 6. If they are on foot or in a vehicle, if so the make and model of the vehicle.
